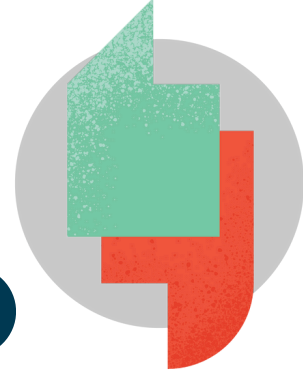

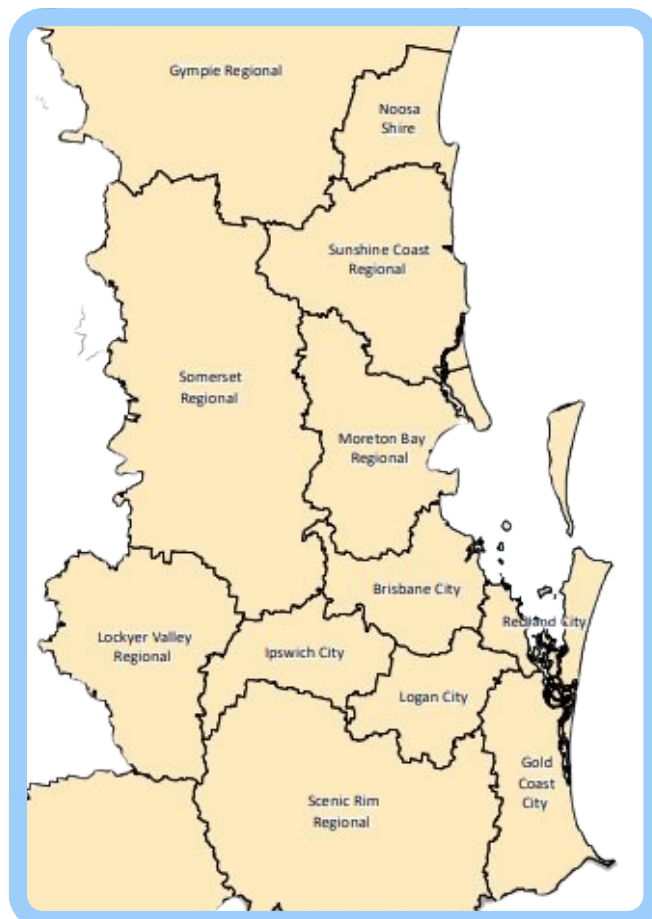
Tropical Cyclone Alfred has left many people confused about what legal and social supports are available.

Domestic violence and elder abuse	Any abuse concerns
Employment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • dismissal • stand down • unpaid wages • leave concerns • gig workers • sexual harrasment
Family law	Parenting order contraventions and variations arising due to the disaster e.g. temporary re-location
Discrimination and human rights breaches	Access to needed government services, police powers and disaster-related offences
Insurance claims	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • house • car • contents
Utilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • electricity • water • gas • telephone or internet
Financial hardship	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • disaster payments and grants • contract leases • debt & mortgage stress
Fences and trees	damage to or from neighbouring property
Retirement Villages and Manufactured Park homes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • liveability • damage to common areas
Body corporate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • access • insurance • livability
Bailment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • car • personal property
Sole traders & family only business	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • insurance • leasing • property damage • financial hardship
Post death or coronial concerns	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • burial disputes • Problems having remains released or transported
Disaster specific issues	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • volunteers • grants • emergency services • replacement ID
